Other Helpful Information

Pallbearers: Please designate (6) pallbearers (healthy men) from your family and friends attending the funeral. Pallbearers need to be available at the burial site.

Floral Bearers: Please designate (4) persons. They are responsible to collect the floral arrangements and transport it to your place of choosing.

Facebook Live: CEBC has the capability to livestream the funeral for guest who have a Facebook account and who cannot physically attend, barring any technical difficulties. On Facebook, go to Calvary Evangelical Baptist Church, next go to Videos, and press the live link. CEBC will only keep the post available for 48 hours after the funeral. We highly recommend that you save or download that post immediately.
